PREREQUISITES:	None	MATERIAL FEE: \$21
DESCRIPTION:	In this year-long class we will study criminal justice using the book "Criminal Justice in America," published by the Constitutional Rights Foundation. Each of the book's units (described briefly below) contain four chapters, and we will cover one per week. Students will need to read the material in advance (about an hour each week) to prepare for in-class analysis, activities, and discussions. Teacher is a licensed attorney.
